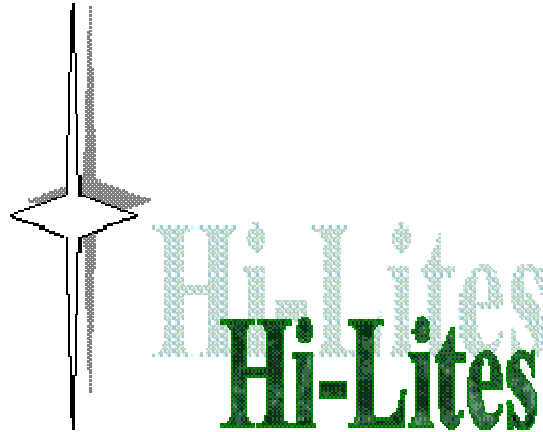

The Hi-Lites this week go out to all those leading/helping with Children's Church and all those who helped with worship service on Sunday.

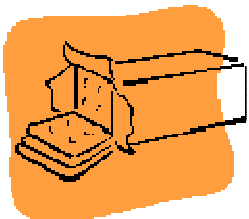

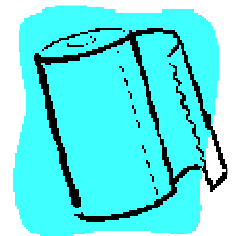
